



Renton Municipal Arts Commission Bravo Award

The Renton Municipal Arts Commission recognizes individuals in the Renton Community that have made arts and culture a vital part of the community by awarding the Bravo Award. Individuals selected by the Commission to receive this prestigious award must meet at least one of the following criteria:

- Served in leadership role in arts organization
- Created art, art program/projects, or an organization that has had a positive impact on the art and culture of the City of Renton.
- Work has spurred additional creative endeavors within the City of Renton.
- Eligible candidates can be artists, patrons, supporters, teachers, authors, and appreciators of art.

How to nominate an individual for the Bravo Award:

A nominating letter may be sent to the Renton Municipal Arts Commission stating how the individual has made a difference in the arts and culture community and meets the criteria stated above. The letter should include the contact information for the person submitting the nomination as well as the Bravo Award nominee.
